OFFICE NON-RECORDING POLICY

It is the strict policy of Kenneth Wilstead, DMD, PA (hereinafter referred to as the "Practice"), to not allow recording(s) (either video or audio), of its office location, staff, employees, or patients, by any other person(s), besides the Practice itself.
